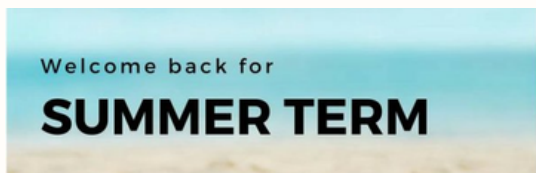

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Space Odyssey Visit

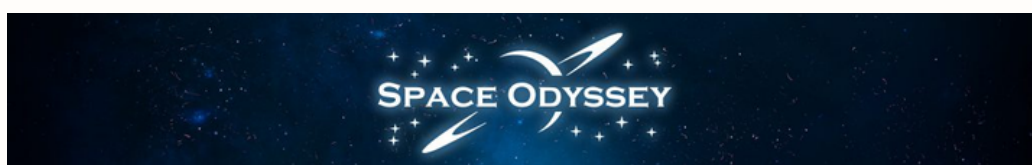
SPACE ODYSSEY OFFERS SPECTACULAR 360° 3D SPACE AND BIOLOGY LEARNING EXPERIENCE FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS OF ALL AGES!

Next Wednesday, our children will enjoy a special visit taking their learning to another dimension.

Every one of Space Odyssey's fascinating planetarium presentations is led by Simon Ould, an experienced Science Teacher and Fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society. Simon uses his extensive teaching and lecturing experience to carefully adapt the delivery and content of every presentation to be appropriate for the particular group involved. High-resolution images, movies and sophisticated computer simulations are projected throughout Space Odyssey's inflatable dome – above, behind and all around the audience – to create a breathtakingly immersive and inspirational learning experience!

This wonderful immersive dome experience will be in our School Hall! KS1 children will enjoy a bespoke session learning about how and where scientists are searching for evidence of alien life, in our own solar system – and beyond! KS2 children will be having a specialist session learning about light, gravity & our amazing solar system. This fun and engaging experience really is not to be missed! The show reinforces concepts learned in school, in a lively and interesting way that really engages the children.
