 - ✓ Identifying those involved
 - ✓ Taking steps to repair harm and to prevent recurrence

We hope you will:

- Support the school's policies on behaviour and uniform;
- Make sure that your child arrives on time (school sessions start at 9:00 am);
- Make sure your child attends regularly, providing a note of explanation for absence and avoiding holiday in term time or the occasional day off;
- Attend appointments to discuss your child's progress;
- Support your child in learning to read and in completing homework.

We hope children will:

- Follow the school rules;
- Join in fully with the life of the school;
- Show a positive attitude to school activities;
- Be thoughtful and well mannered towards others.
