We are pleased to take this opportunity to commend our students on their exemplary demonstration of the school values of Friendship & Respect during their recent playtimes. It has been heartening to witness the kindness, thoughtfulness, and inclusivity displayed by our children, ensuring that every child enjoys their break times and fostering a sense of camaraderie through teamwork activities. Well done to all the children for their positive contributions.

Looking ahead, we would like to inform you that on the 1st of July, our Farthing Wood students will be participating in a Poetry Slam Performance in Liskeard alongside Landulph and Dobwall Schools. Throughout June, all our students (across all classes) will be engaged in composing and performing their own poetry related to World Thinking Day, under the theme 'Our World, Our Thriving Futures'. Liskeard Poetry Society will be assisting the children with the composition of their poems, leading up to the Poetry Slam performance for KS2 pupils. This project will culminate in KS2 performances and the creation of an anthology featuring poems from all schools and all the children in our Trust. It promises to be an exciting collaborative endeavour that I am sure the children are eagerly anticipating.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this change, but we believe it is imperative to allow our students ample time for rehearsals in preparation for each event.

Looking ahead to Monday, 10th of June, we are optimistic for sunny weather on our Sports Day. 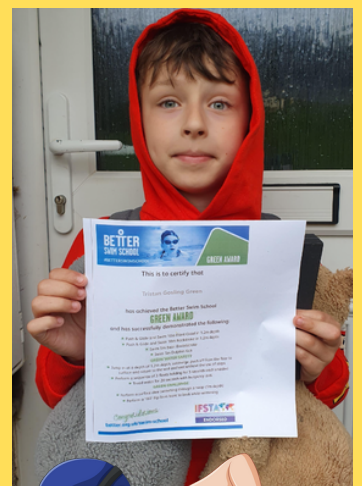
