For many generations, my family has played in different brass bands across the country including:

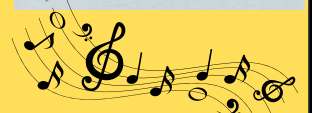
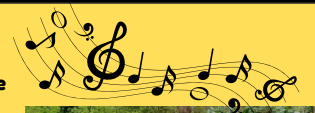
Saltash Town Band, Bodmin Town Band and Kibworth Band.
