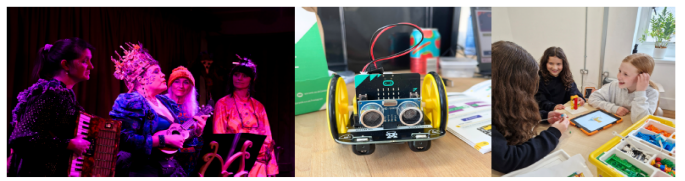
Half Term Pumpkin Trail
