Please see attached this month's online safety newsletter. This month offers advice should you receive any new technology over the Christmas period as well as tips on cyber bullying and Roblox.

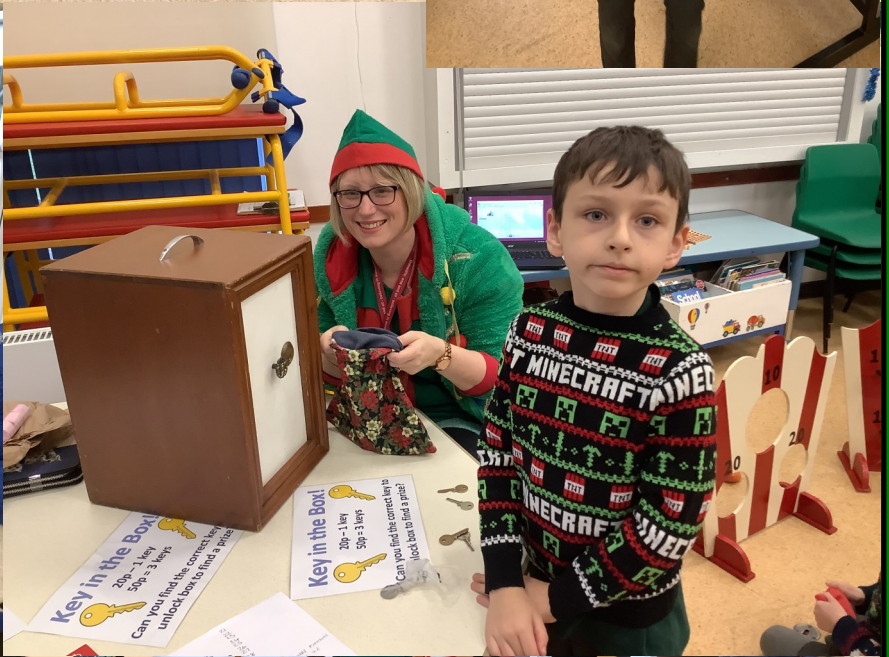
