Dear Parents and Carers,

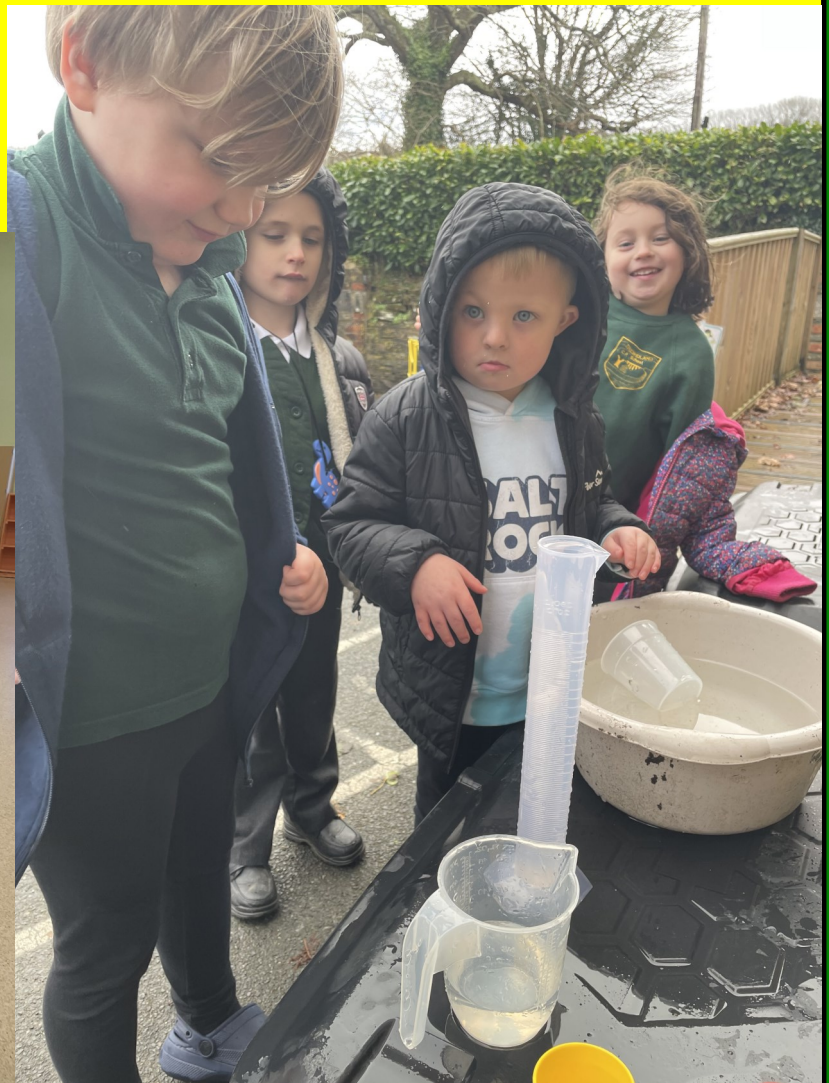

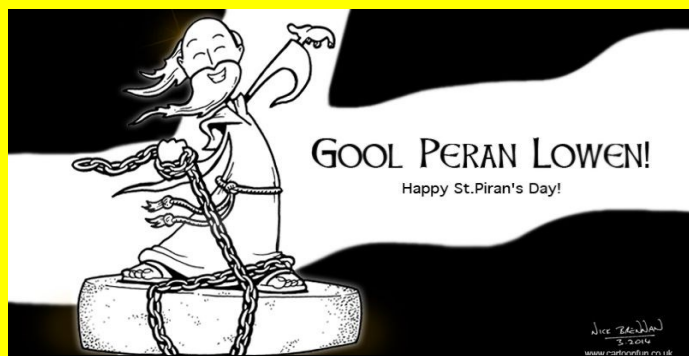

to purchase books for the School

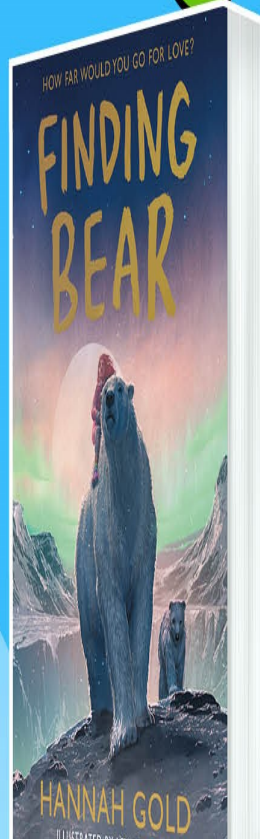
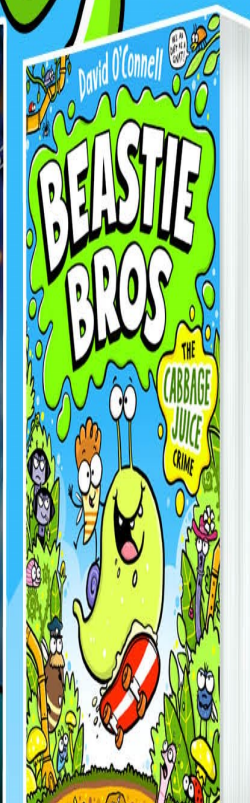
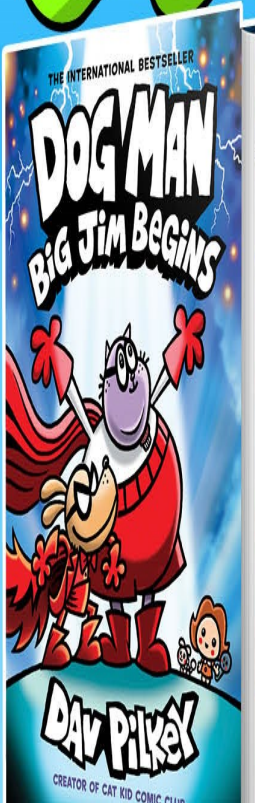
