### World Oral Health Day

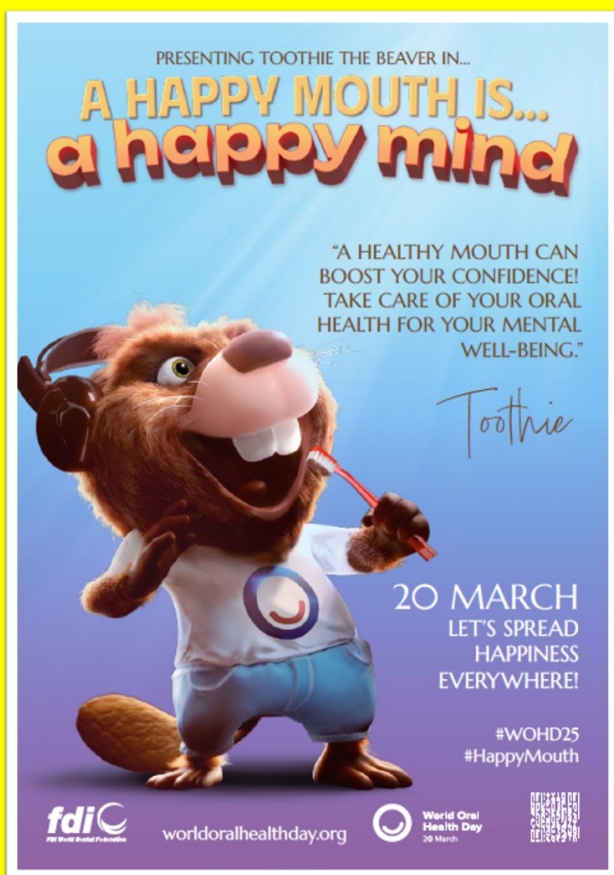
