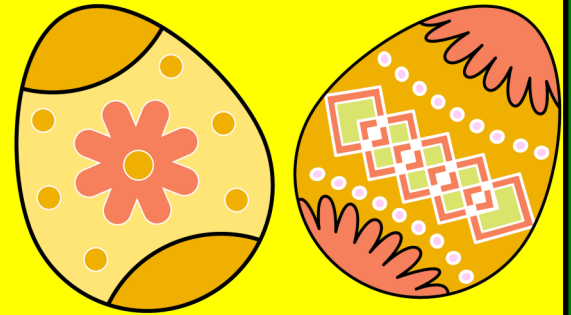

I wish you all a very happy Easter and look forward to seeing you all soon.

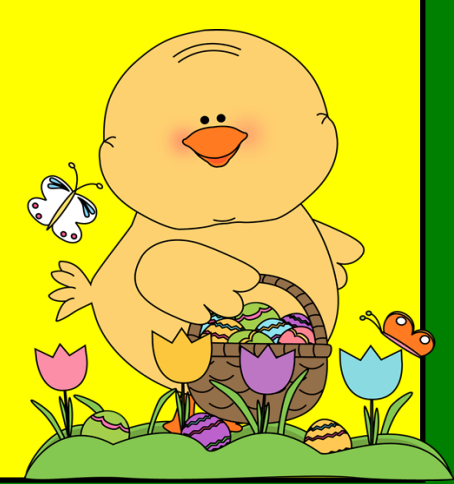
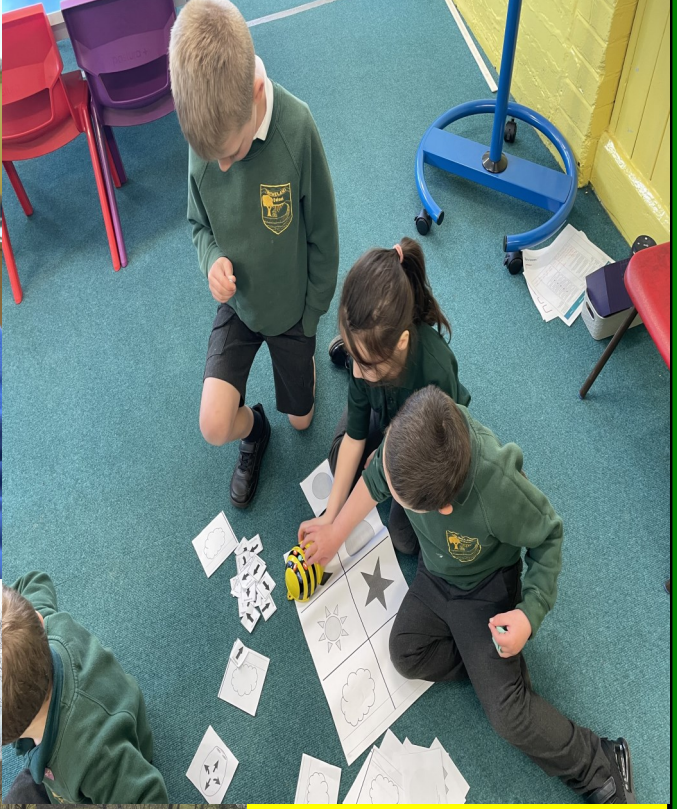
