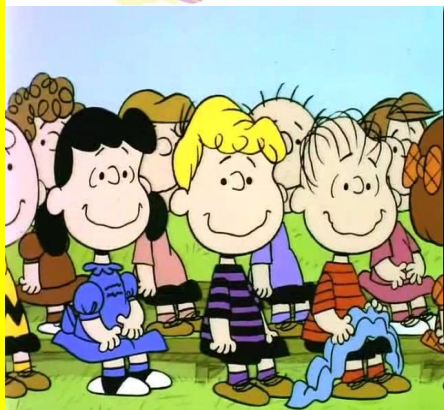


Kid's Corner

Grow your own!

The Parish Council has funded a small grow bag for each primary school age child in our Parish and Trewidland School.

You can pick up your grow bag and seeds for free on the 6th May between 3pm and 4pm at St Keyne Village Hall and Trewidland Village Hall.

We will arrange a small results show in late August, early September. Details and entry form will be published in the August edition of this magazine. Also please keep an eye out on FB for any updates

There will be a choice 2 seeds of each, 2x courgette, 2x tomatoes, 2x cucumber and 2x sunflower

First of all, the grow bag needs to be filled with 10 litres of water to expand. Please follow the instructions on the bag.

Then plant your seed in the compost of the bag, keep moist and in a sunny place outside.

Take photos of your plants as they emerge from the compost and make a little plant growing diary.

Take a photo of the vegetables on your plate and maybe the recipe you or your family used to cook the vegetable.
