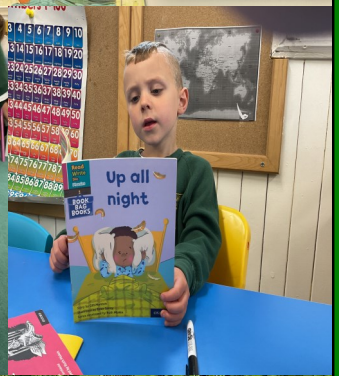
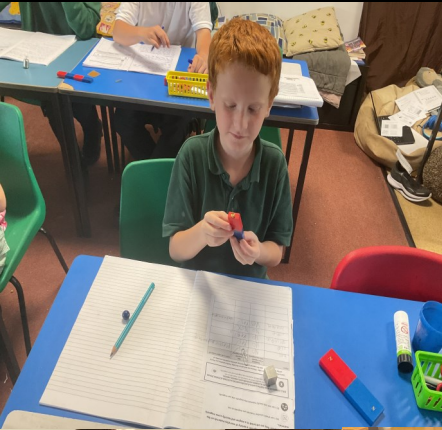

MARATHON RUNNING CHALLENGE

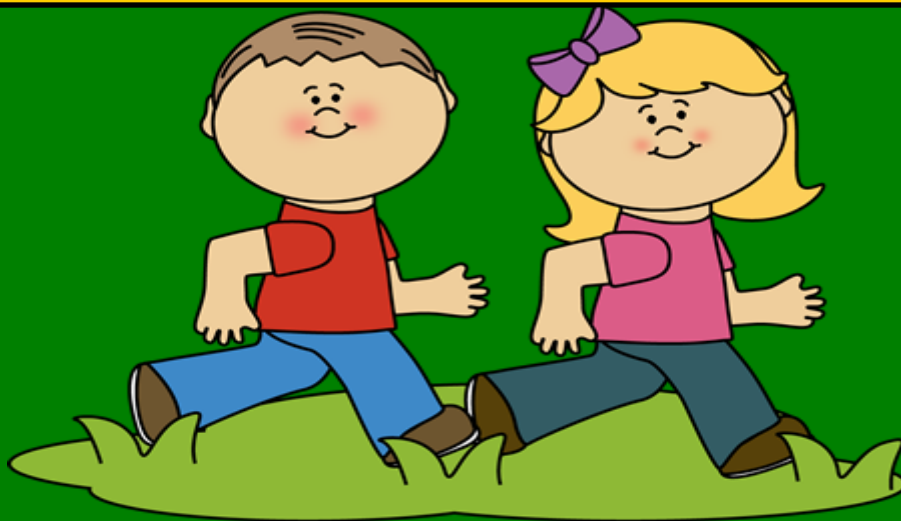
Thursday 17 July
