I hope you all have a lovely weekend,

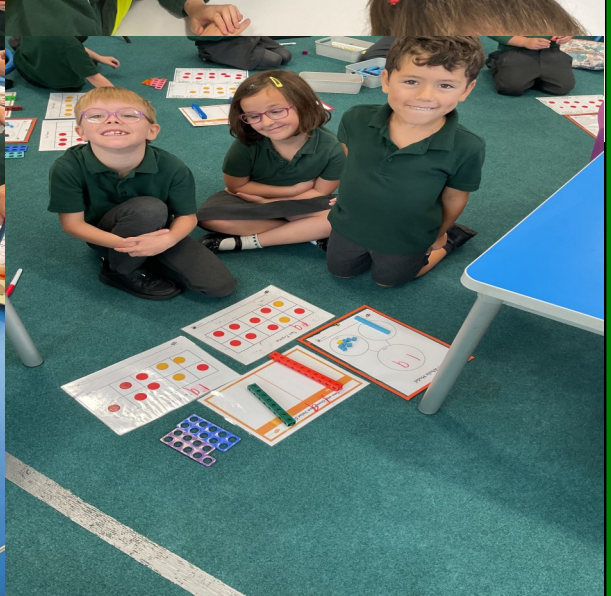
