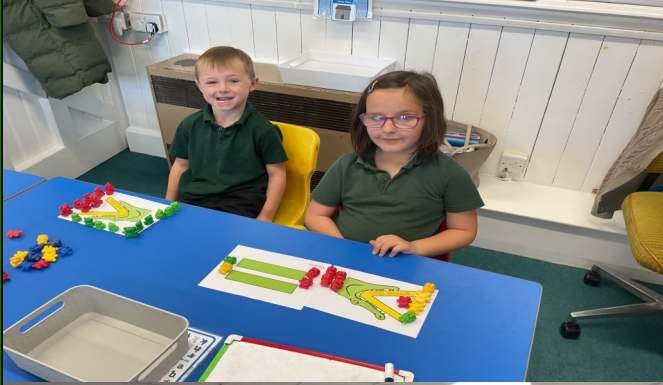
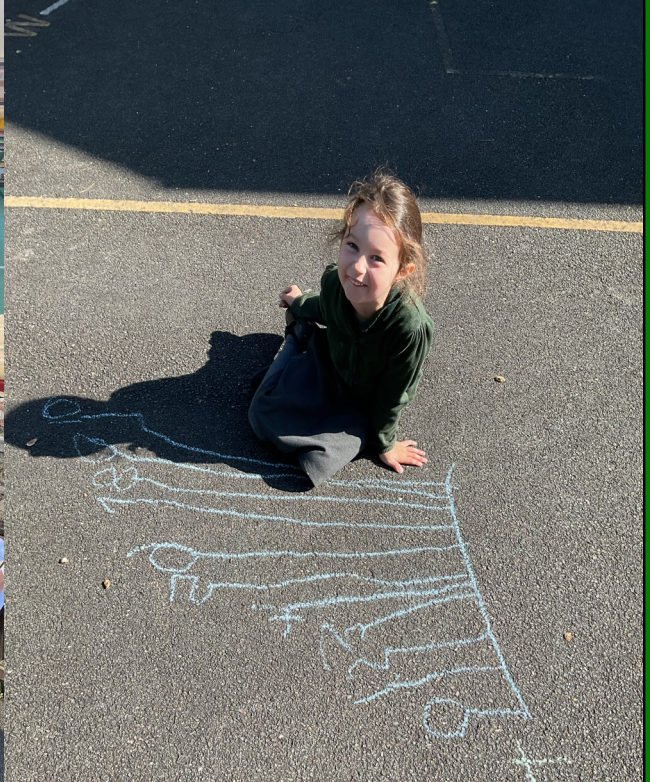

- Every session will have tea and cake and a free crèche.



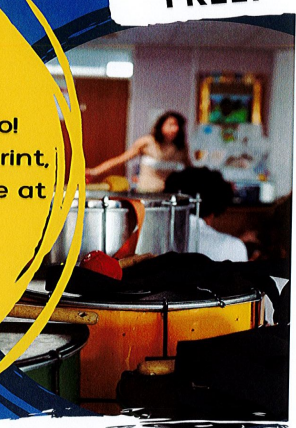
