Hello Trewidland Primary and Pre-School

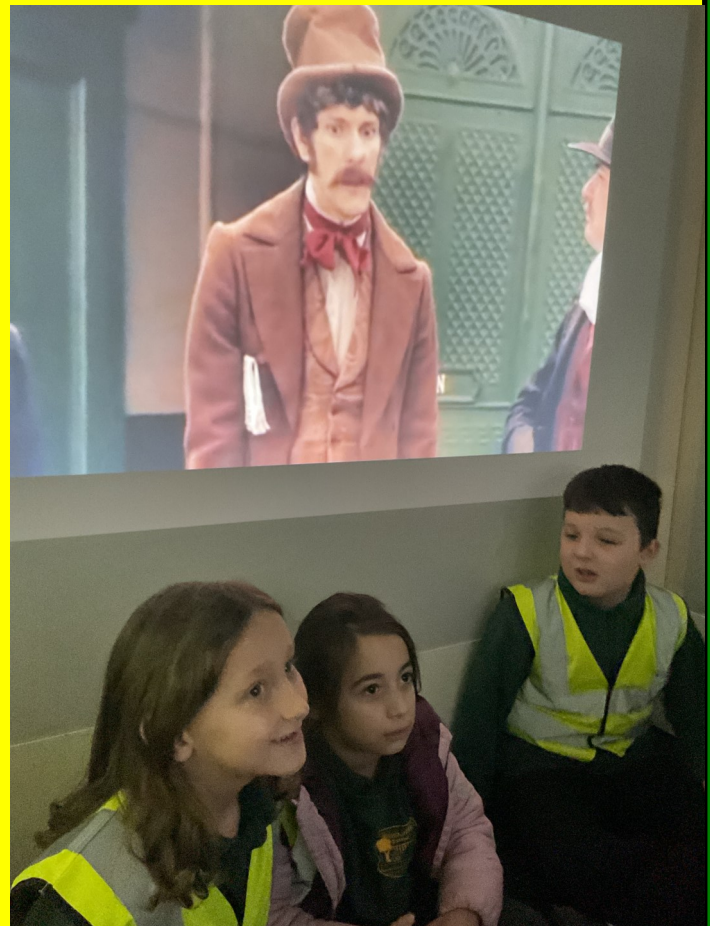
