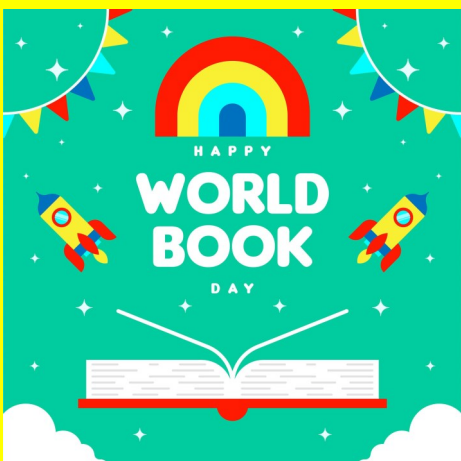

We also provide a specialised education provision for learners aged 16 to 25 with an EHC at Kehelland College.



Within our 16 acre site we have horticultural growing spaces for fruit, vegetables, perennials and annuals, Cornish orchards, Community Tree Nursery and wildlife areas.
