Professional photographers and videographers will be visiting **Trewidland Primary and Pre-school** to capture images and video for school promotional materials on the 24th April 2026.

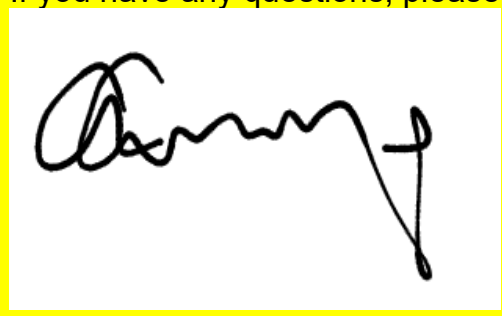
