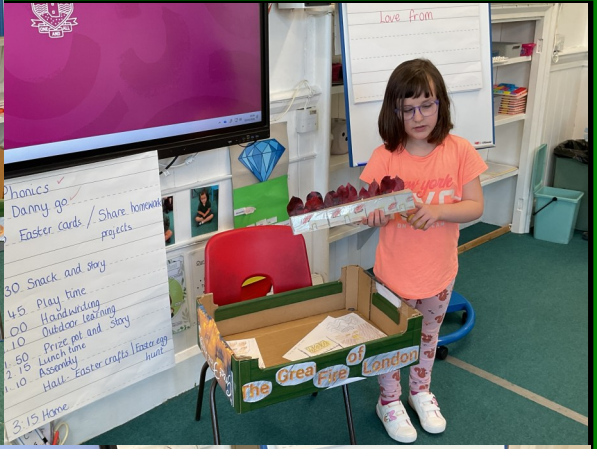
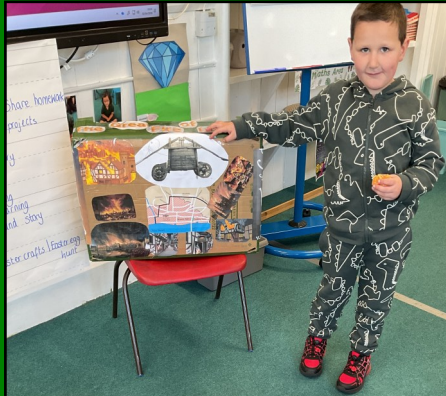




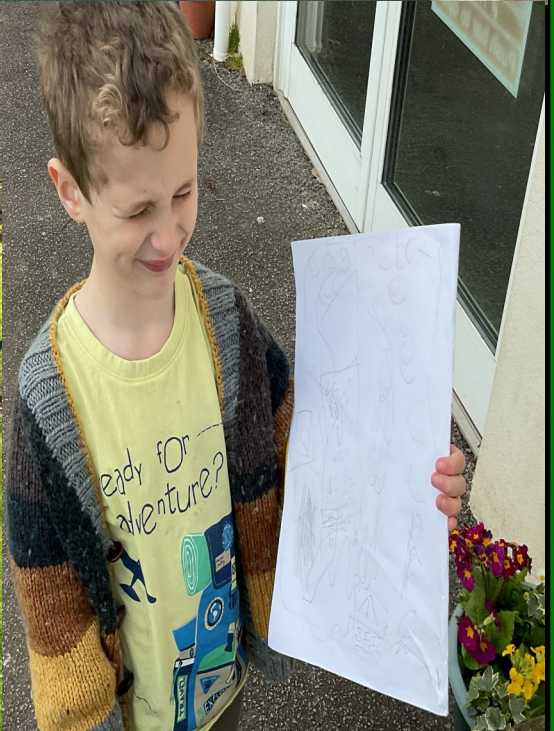
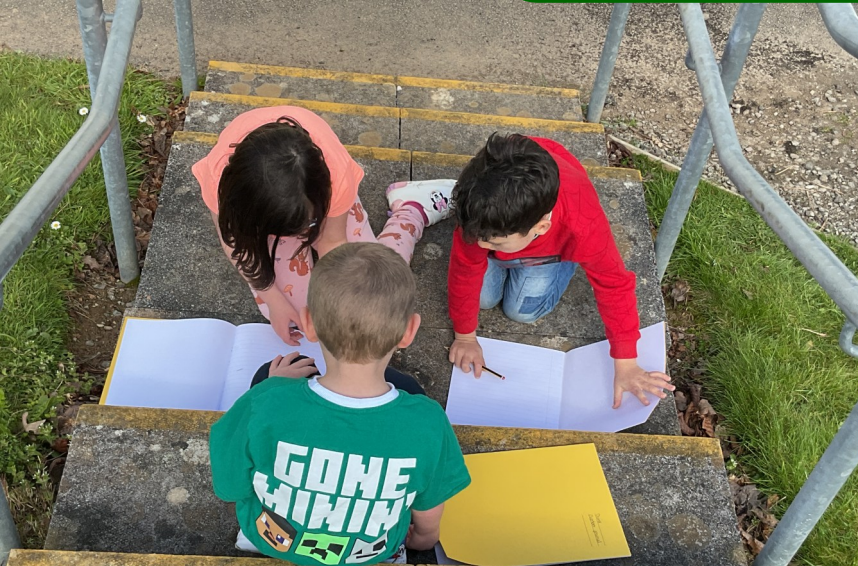
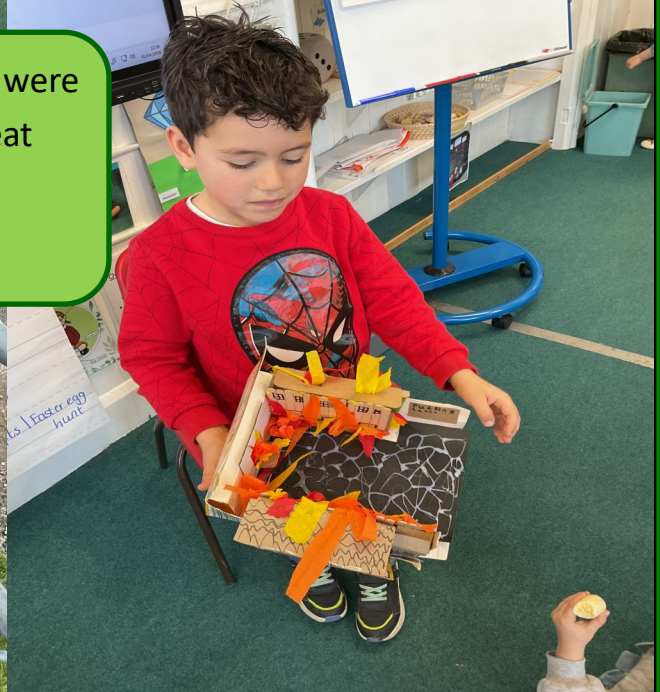
The children in Class 2 were learning about the position and structure of our teeth and the different types of teeth and when they come through.
