

### English

We will explore Earth's history through a narrative - 'The Ever-Changing Earth' by Grahame Baker-Smith. We will identify terminology, answer questions, create leaflets and continue the story. For our non-fiction, we will write an informal letter from the perspective of an Anglo-Saxon. We will continue to develop our spellings with regular spelling practice.

### Mathematics

We will continue to learn about fractions as the term starts. We will learn about unit fractions and what makes a mixed number/ improper fraction. We will also move on to learn about percentages. Our Real-Life Maths focus will be on geometry- position and direction. We will continue to use Times Table Rockstars and songs to help us recap and practice our times tables daily, along with our arithmetic skills.

### Science

In Science, we will learn about teeth and the digestive system, including the roles of different body parts involved. We will write a diary entry from the perspective of food traveling through the digestive system. We will also explore the types of teeth in humans and animals, their names and their functions.

### Anglo Saxons



### History

In History, we will learn all about Anglo Saxons. We will look at timelines and how Anglo Saxons link with Romans; our previous history topic. We will identify the similarities and differences between England during Anglo Saxon times compared to now.

### Religious Education

Our RE lessons this half term, will explore the question: What do Hindu's believe God is like? We will explore the concept of deities and how Hindu's worship at home too.

### French

This half term, we will be describing family members and pets, with a focus on understanding the basic grammar and how to apply it.

### Creativity: Art

For art this half term, we will focus on sculpture. We will make sculptures inspired by an Anglo-Saxon village. We will start by looking at structures and exploring some sketches surrounding different structures. We will then learn how to join different materials and explore some of our own ideas.

### Computing

We will be furthering our programming skills, focusing on repetition and loops. The children will design a wrapping paper with repeating patterns.

### Music

In music, we will explore a wide range of musical styles, listen, sing, play, compose, and perform.

### PE

Our days for PE are WEDNESDAY and FRIDAY , so the children will need to come in wearing their PE kit this day.
