



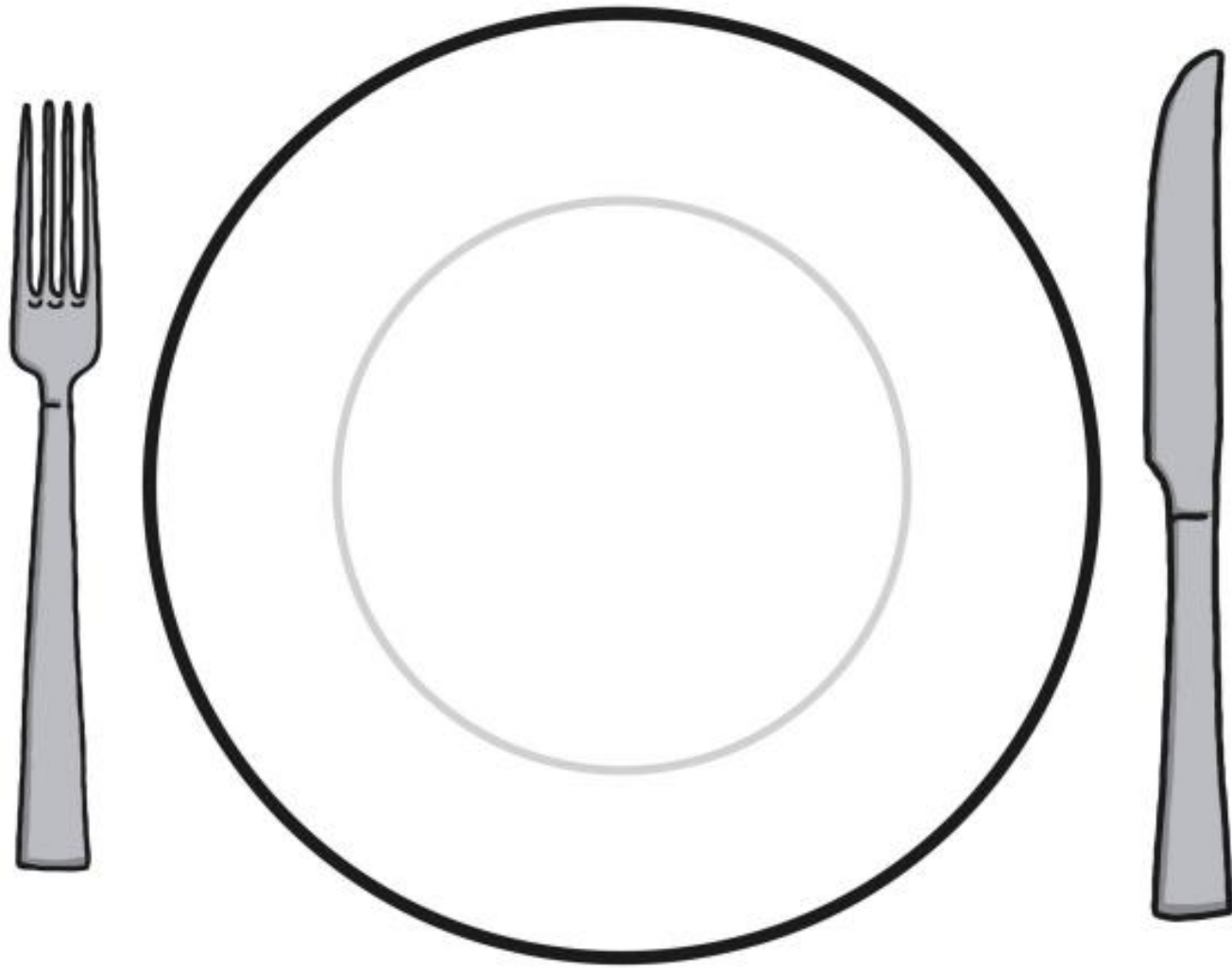
EYFS Homework menu Summer Term (2nd half) 2026

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw three of your favourite things about being in Lerryn Class. • Talk about what you have learnt during your first year at school. What would you like to learn in Fowey Class?
Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn 3 new words and explain what they mean to a grown up at school. • Tell your family 5 facts about staying safe at the beach. • Learn one of our 'rhymes of the week' off by heart and perform it.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make an obstacle course like the one in our garden and time yourself completing it. • Practice your handwriting of every letter in the alphabet - capitals and lower case. • Design and draw a healthy meal on the plate below.
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the text map below to re-tell the story 'Handa's Surprise.' • Practice reading your RWI book or ditty every day. • Ask a grown up to say a CCVC/CVCC word, e.g. clap, test. Can you write the word by yourself? Can you write a multi-syllabic word. e.g. under, shorter, flying?
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • count beyond 20 - how far can you count accurately? Can you count to 100? • Complete the doubling number activity below. • Practice writing numbers to at least 20 correctly and the right way around.
Understanding the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose a job where people help others, e.g. Lifeguard, nurse, vet, fire fighter, police officer etc. Make a poster with pictures and writing to show others what they do. • Make a healthy meal or snack, e.g. a fruit salad, bread rolls etc. Take some photographs to show and tell at school.
Expressive Arts and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make your own musical instrument from some dried pasta and a cardboard tube. Use your instrument to play a song. • Create a picture of the beach or coastline.

Handa's Surprise

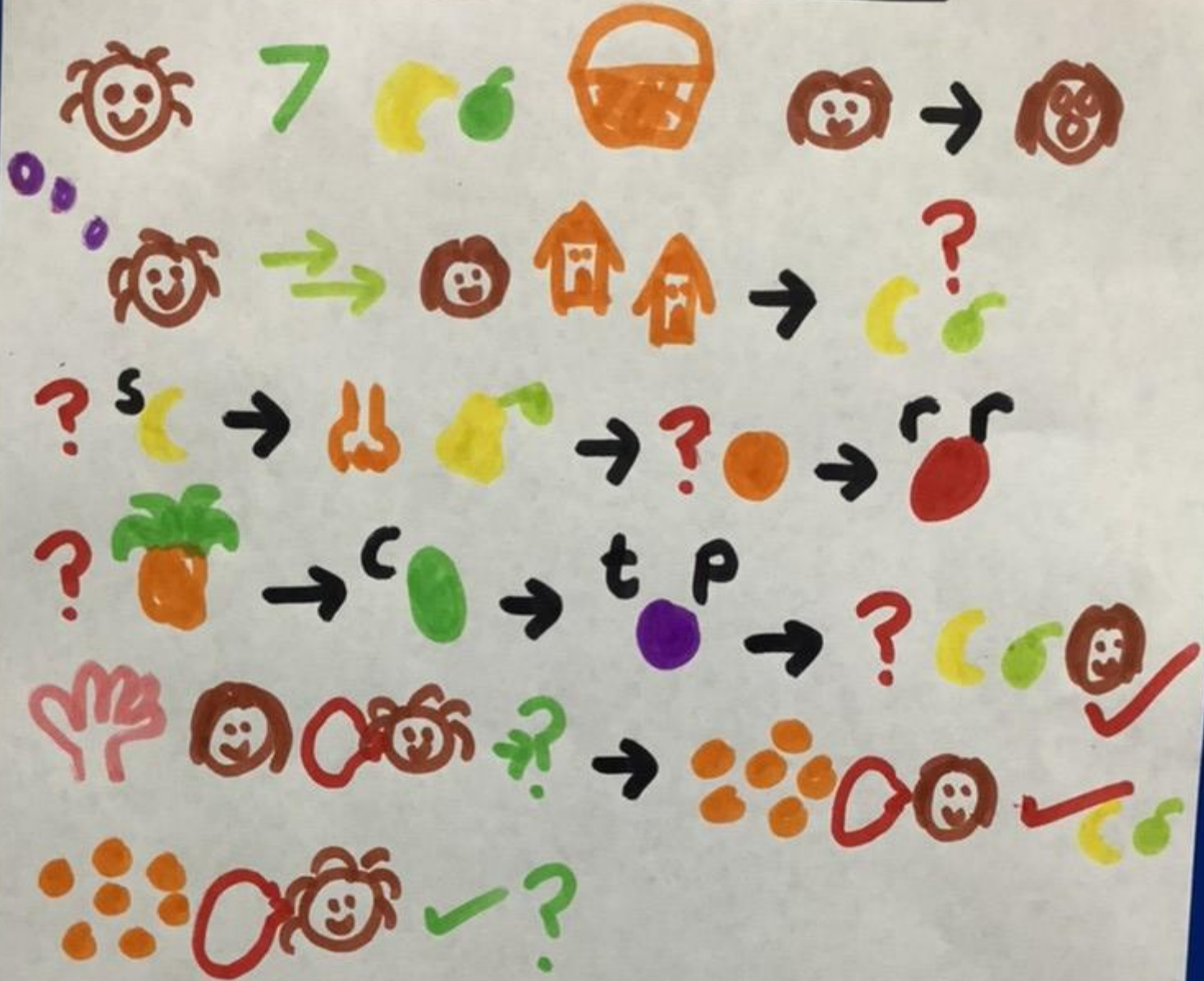

"Hello, Akeyo," said Handa. "I've brought you a surprise."

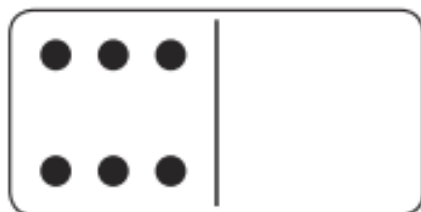
"Tangerines! Said Akeyo. "My favourite fruit."

"TANGERINES?" said Handa. That *is* a surprise!"

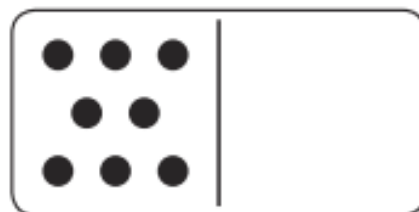
